32	'Sec. 1. Use of alternative outdoor playground surface. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the
34	Department of Conservation work with representatives of the Department of Education, the Department of Environmental
36	Protection and the Executive Department, State Planning Office to develop a pilot project to evaluate the use of waste tire
38	material as a playground surfacing material. The playground chosen for the pilot project must be within a state park or
40	recreation area managed by the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands. The material used must conform to guidelines
42	for outdoor playground surfaces developed by the Department of Education in accordance with Resolve 2003, chapter 10. The waste
44	tire material may be restricted to certain areas within the playground. Implementation of the pilot project is contingent on
46	the director's securing necessary funding from private and public sources.

The Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands shall report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over agriculture, conservation and forestry matters by January 15, 2005 on the pilot project, including a description of the project location and areas surfaced, the type, source and cost of waste tire material used and the plan for evaluating the material.'

## **SUMMARY**

12 This amendment changes the bill to a resolve. It directs the Director of the Bureau of Parks with the Department of 14 Conservation and Lands to develop and implement a pilot project for evaluating the use of waste tire material as a playground 16 surfacing material.

## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The requirement that the Department of Conservation must, contingent upon the availability of funding from private and public sources, develop and implement a pilot playground project will increase the department's Other Special Revenue Funds expenditures and revenue collections. The amounts will depend on the final scope of the pilot project and can not be determined at this time.

The Department of Education, the Department of Environmental Protection and the State Planning Office will incur additional minor costs in working with the Department of Conservation on the design and implementation of this pilot project.
