Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §606, sub-§8, as amended by PL 2001, c. 711, 4 §8, is further amended to read:

8. Limits on price. An agency liquor store shall sell all spirits and fortified wine purchased from the commission at the retail price established by the commission, except that, beginning July 1, 2005, an agency liquor store shall sell all
spirits and fortified wine purchased from the commission at a price equal to the sum of the retail price established by the light for the sum of the retail price.

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SUMMARY

This bill provides that, beginning July 1, 2005, an agency liquor store shall sell all spirits and fortified wine purchased from the State Liquor and Lottery Commission at a price equal to the sum of the retail price established by the commission and 5% of that retail price.
