SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 945, L.D. 1273, Bill, "An Act To Extend Term Limits"


Amend the amendment in section 2 in the question in the last line (page 2, line 5 in amendment) by striking out the following: "beginning with the 122nd Legislature" and inserting in its place the following: 'beginning with those Legislators first elected to nonconsecutive terms of office beginning in December 2004'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. Application. The 6-consecutive-term limit imposed by this Act for Legislators applies to Legislators elected or reelected to their first nonconsecutive terms of office beginning with the 122nd Legislature.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies the referendum question and specifies that the extension of term limits applies only to Legislators, beginning with those Legislators first elected or reelected to nonconsecutive terms of office beginning with the 122nd Legislature.
