SUMMARY

14 The amendment clarifies the timing of an election to withdraw from the state health insurance plan and to preserve the 16 option of reenrolling. A person may elect to decline health insurance coverage at the time of retirement and retain the option to reenroll pursuant to the provisions of this new law, or 18 a person may elect to withdraw from health coverage at any time after retirement, provided the person had elected at the time of 20 retirement to be covered by the state health insurance plan. It 22 also clarifies the conditions under which the spouse or dependent of a retiree may enroll in the state health insurance plan.
