Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §553, sub-§§1 and 2, as enacted by IB 1993,
4 c. 1, §1 and affected by §2, are amended to read:

1. State Senate. A person may not serve more than -4- 7
consecutive terms as a state Senator.

2. State Representative. A person may not serve more
10 than -4- 7 consecutive terms as a member of the state House of
Representatives.
