
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 418, L.D. 1287, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Life Safety Requirements for Residential Care Facilities"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 by inserting at the end the following:

'D. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or rule a residential care facility with 4 or fewer beds is not required to obtain certification from a design specialist to satisfy the requirements of this section or Title 5, section 4594-F.'

SUMMARY

This amendment exempts residential care facilities with 4 or fewer beds from the requirements of certification by a design specialist.
