Sec. NNN-2. Calculation and transfer. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Budget Officer shall calculate the amount of savings in section 1 of this Part that applies against each General Fund account for all affected departments and agencies from Personal Services from the elimination of General Fund positions that are based in and around a 30-mile radius of Augusta and shall transfer the amounts by financial order upon the approval of the Governor. These transfers are considered adjustments to appropriations in fiscal years 2003-04 and 2004-05. The State Budget Officer shall provide the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs reports of the eliminated positions and amounts transferred, by agency and account, no later than September 15, 2003 and September 15, 2004.

Sec. NNN-3. Implementing language. Notwithstanding Part C of this Act, within 30 days of enactment of this Act, the Department of Education shall submit implementing language to the Legislature making changes to Part C necessitated by this Part.'
