HOUSE AMENDMENT "**N**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 973, L.D. 1319, Bill, "An Act Making Unified Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government, General Fund and Other Funds, and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2004 and June 30, 2005"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part MMM the following:

PART NNN

Sec. NNN-1. Implementation of learning results. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a school administrative unit, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 26, may not be required to implement the system of learning results established in Title 20-A, section 6209 before July 1, 2005.

Sec. NNN-2. Implementing language. Notwithstanding Part C of this Act, within 30 days of the effective date of this Part the Department of Education shall submit implementing language to the Legislature making changes to Part C necessitated by this Part.

Sec. NNN-3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.


