Sec. NNN-3. Use of money saved. Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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SUMMARY

This amendment deappropriates funds for recruitment and 30 retention stipends at the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Revenue Services and funds budgeted 32 for repairs and renovations to the State House. It also funds the Office of Program Evaluation and Government Accountability at 34 a lower level than originally budgeted and requires a payback to the affected departments once the Office of Program Evaluation 36 and Government Accountability is operational.
