HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 992, L.D. 1350, Bill, "An Act To Assist Seasonal Workers with Workers' Compensation"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph C by striking out all of subparagraph (2) (page 1, lines 18 to 21 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'(2) Notwithstanding subparagraph (1), the term "seasonal worker" includes, but is not limited to, any employee who is employed directly in agriculture ~~or in the harvesting or initial hauling of forest products.~~

SUMMARY

This amendment puts back in the bill the language that deems agricultural workers seasonal workers for the purpose of determining average weekly wages. The amendment removes the provision that makes harvesting or forest products workers seasonal workers, as did the bill.
