HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 996, L.D. 1354, Bill, "An Act To Permit Video Gaming for Money Conducted by Nonprofit Organizations"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting before the 2nd indented paragraph from the end the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 8 in that part designated "§365." in subsection 2 in paragraph A by striking out all of the last 5 lines (page 6, lines 47 to 49 and page 7, lines 1 and 2 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following: 'inability to communicate with the central computer system:' '

Further amend the amendment on page 6 by inserting before the 4th indented paragraph from the end the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 8 in that part designated "§395." in subsection 4 in paragraph A in subparagraph (4) in the last line (page 23, line 43 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "machine" the following: 'and any monetary contents' '

SUMMARY

This amendment makes 2 technical changes to ensure that the committee amendment is internally consistent.

The first change removes a reference to a phase-in period that was removed by Committee Amendment "A" and the 2nd change
