COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 445, L.D. 1357, Bill, "An Act To Encourage Economic Development in Piscataquis County"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§125." in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the 4th line (page 1, line 48 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "municipalities" the following: 'or unorganized territories'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§125." in subsection 1 in paragraph B in subparagraph (1) in the 8th line (page 3, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "equal to" the following: 'at least'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the definition of what activities constitute "county economic development" in Piscataquis County includes activities in unorganized territories. It also clarifies that, in order for the election results to be valid, the total number of votes cast must be equal to at least 50% of the total number of votes cast in Piscataquis County in the most recent gubernatorial election.
