Other members of the commission who are not otherwise compensated by their employers or other entities that they represent are entitled to receive 6 reimbursement of necessary expenses and, upon a demonstration of financial hardship, a per diem equal to the legislative per diem 8 for their attendance at authorized meetings; and be it further' ' 10

Further amend the amendment in section 10 in the 3rd line 12 from the end (page 3, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "1,310" and inserting in its place the following: 14 '1,271'

SUMMARY

This amendment authorizes the commission to hold up to 2 24 meetings and directs the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, rather than the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis, to 26 staff the commission. This amendment removes language that directed the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to use 28 funds in the fish hatchery maintenance fund to reimburse costs associated with the per diem and expenses of commission members. 30 The amendment also reduces the appropriation.

This amendment deallocates \$39 in Other Special Revenue Funds from the Legislature for the Commission. The total amount still available will then be \$1,711, which will cover the two meetings authorized in fiscal year 2003-04.
