SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 446, L.D. 1358, "Resolve, To Reestablish the Commission To Study the Needs and Opportunities Associated with the Production of Salmonid Sport Fish in Maine"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting after subsection 9 the following:

'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

**'Sec. 3. Appointments; convening of commission; meetings. Resolved:** That all appointments must be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this resolve. The appointing authorities shall notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council once all appointments have been completed. The chairs shall call and convene the first meeting of the commission no later than August 15, 2003. The commission is authorized to hold up to 2 meetings; and be it further'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 6 and inserting in its place the following:

**'Sec. 6. Compensation. Resolved:** That members who are Legislators are entitled to the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, and reimbursement for necessary expenses incurred for their

2 attendance at authorized meetings of the commission that occur on  
3 days the Legislature is not in session. Other members of the  
4 commission who are not otherwise compensated by their employers  
5 or other entities that they represent are entitled to receive  
6 reimbursement of necessary expenses and, upon a demonstration of  
7 financial hardship, a per diem equal to the legislative per diem  
8 for their attendance at authorized meetings; and be it further' '

10 Further amend the amendment in section 10 in the 3rd line  
11 from the end (page 3, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the  
12 following: "1,310" and inserting in its place the following:  
13 '1,271'

14 Further amend the amendment in section 10 in the last line  
15 (page 3, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following:  
16 "\$1,750" and inserting in its place the following: '\$1,711'

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**SUMMARY**

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21 This amendment authorizes the commission to hold up to 2  
22 meetings and removes language that directed the Commissioner of  
23 Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to use funds in the fish hatchery  
24 maintenance fund to reimburse costs associated with the per diem  
25 and expenses of commission members. The amendment also reduces  
26 the appropriation.


