Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6029-A is enacted to read:
§6029-A. Safety and security services
The department may provide safety and security services in
the coastal waters of the State. The department shall coordinate
with other local, state and federal agencies when the department
provides such safety and security services.
SUMMARY
This bill provides that the Department of Marine Resources
may provide safety and security services in the coastal waters when conditions warrant, and coordinate with local, state and
federal agencies when such services are provided.
