SUMMARY

The amendment changes the date, from May 1, 2003 to February 16 16, 2004, by which the Commissioner of Environmental Protection and the Commissioner of Human Services must submit a 18 comprehensive assessment on the progress in eliminating the discharge of dioxin from bleach kraft pulp mills in the State. 20 The amendment also deletes the annual requirement for the commissioners to submit progress reports.
