22 This bill amends the Highway Fund budget for fiscal years
23 2003-04 and 2004-05 to provide \$3,000,000 in funding for
24 construction of Department of Transportation and municipal sand
25 and salt storage facilities. This bill also revises enforcement
26 deadlines for Department of Transportation compliance with
27 groundwater classification of sand and salt storage areas to
28 reflect funding and requires the Department of Transportation and
the Department of Environmental Protection to work together to
ensure the best possible expenditure of available funds.
