2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §1827, sub-§3** is enacted to read:

6 **3. Camper confidentiality.** Notwithstanding Title 1,  
8 chapter 13, subchapter 1, the names of campers, other identifying  
10 information and dates of a reservation are confidential and are  
12 not subject to public disclosure during the calendar year for  
14 which a reservation is made.

### 12 SUMMARY

14 This bill protects campers by making confidential camper  
16 names, other identifying information and reservation dates during  
18 the calendar year for which the reservation is made. The purpose  
of this bill is to prevent situations involving possible domestic  
and child custody problems and potential unwanted contacts.
