_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2926, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 439,
4	Pt. EEEE, §5, is amended to read:
6	5. Call answering coverage. The bureau is not required to provide for or use surcharge funding for local 911 call answering

14	1-B. Statewide E-9-1-1 surcharge. The activities authorized under this chapter are funded through a special

20	public access lines. The statewide E-9-1-1 surcharge may not be imposed on more than 25 lines or numbers per customer billing
22	account. In the case of cellular or wireless telecommunications service subscribers, the place of residence of those subscribers
24	must be determined according to the sourcing rules for mobile telecommunications services set forth in Title 36, section 1816.
26	The statewide E-9-1-1 surcharge is 50¢ <u>66¢</u> per month per line or number until90daysafteradjournmentoftheFirstRegular

30	statewide E-9-1-1 surcharge must be billed on a monthly basis by each local exchange telephone utility or cellular or wireless
32	telecommunications service provider and be shown separately as a statewide E-9-1-1 surcharge on the customer's bill.

36	SUMMARY
38	This bill removes the sunset provision that reduces the surcharge for Enhanced 9-1-1 service from 50ϕ to 32ϕ , it
40	increases the surcharge from 50¢ to 66¢ and makes it clear that a county or municipality may not withdraw from the statewide
42	E-9-1-1 system.
