12	This bill makes clear that if a plaintiff establishes that prior to filing a complaint in court, the plaintiff filed a
14	charge of discrimination with the Maine Human Rights Commission and the commission dismissed the case for any reason, the court
16	may award attorneys' fees and damages if the plaintiff prevails at trial.
