	A municipality may enact an ordinance pursuant to section
8	3001 that prohibits the use of engine brakes by a motor vehicle
	within the municipality. The ordinance may prohibit the use of
10	engine brakes for the entire municipality or within a certain
	area of the municipality. For purposes of this section, "engine
12	brakes" includes dynamic brakes, engine compression brakes and
	engine retarders.
