10	Sec. 2. 25 MRSA §2803-B, sub-§1, ¶I is enacted to read:
12	I. Death investigations, including at a minimum the
14	protocol of the Department of the Attorney General regarding such investigations.

20	This bill requires law enforcement agencies to adopt a written policy to deal with death investigations, including the
22	minimum standard protocol for death investigations published by the Department of the Attorney General.
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
