HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 478, L.D. 1440, Bill, "An Act To Establish the Commercial Fishing Safety Council"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "~~§6034.~~" by striking out all of subsection 5 (page 2, lines 46 and 47 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'5. Quorum. A quorum exists when a majority of the members of the council are present, either actually or pursuant to subsection 4.'
