HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1059, L.D. 1447, Bill, "An Act To Improve Enforcement of the State's Natural Resource Protection, Timber Theft and Trespass Laws"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first paragraph after the title (page 1, line 23 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 2 to 4 (page 1, lines 25 to 48 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment in section 5 in the first line (page 2, line 2 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Sec. 5." and inserting in its place the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the amendment in section 5 in the 3rd line (page 2, line 6 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "ranger" the following: 'in any log yard or mill site'

Further amend the amendment on pages 2 and 3 by striking out everything after subsection 6 and before the summary (page 2, lines 18 to 50 and page 3, lines 2 to 4 in amendment)

SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to strike the bill and retains that provision of law in Committee Amendment "A" that requires a trucker or wood scaler to present a trip ticket or record of measurement to a forest ranger upon request. This amendment also retains language from House Amendment "A" to Committee Amendment "A" (H-511) that requires a truck driver in any log yard or mill site to present a copy of the trip ticket upon request by a forest ranger.
