SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1069, L.D. 1464, "Resolve, Amending the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial Services' Authorization To Convey a Portion of the Kennebec Arsenal in Augusta Pursuant to Resolve 1999, Chapter 56 and To Direct Proceeds from the Sale of the Maine State Prison Property in Thomaston"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:



Further amend the resolve in section 2 in section 7 by striking out all of the last line (page 1, line 48 in L.D.)

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 3.

This amendment removes that section of the bill that directed that the proceeds from the sale of the Maine State Prison property in Thomaston be deposited in the Maine State Housing Authority's Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund.

Removing the Maine State Prison property in Thomaston from the requirement that proceeds from its sale be dedicated to the Maine State Housing Authority's Housing Opportunities for Maine Fund will reduce the amount that goes to that fund and increase the amount that would go to the General Fund. The sale price of the property will be set by an independent appraiser.
