This amendment clarifies that the imposition of a fee or charge on a gift obligation is prohibited unless the fee or 4 charge is noted on the gift obligation. Fees and charges must also be in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 33, section 1956, which governs dormancy charges.
