HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1087, L.D. 1482, Bill, "An Act To Revise Certain Provisions of Maine's Fish and Wildlife Laws"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:


'Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7035, sub-§1, ¶C is enacted to read:

C. Notwithstanding paragraph B, a municipality may regulate the operation of all-terrain vehicles on municipal property and on rights-of-way and easements held by that municipality.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that, notwithstanding the State's exclusive jurisdiction over the regulation of all-terrain vehicles, a municipality may regulate the operation of all-terrain vehicles on municipal property and on rights-of-way and easements held by the municipality.
