28	Department of Behavioral and Developmental Services for the provision of mental health services or treatment as of October 1,
30	2003, this Act takes effect upon completion of the term of the current license held by that agency or facility on October 1,

20	This amendment adds a provision to the bill to specify an
38	effective date and to specify that, for any agency or facility that currently holds a license to provide mental health services
40	or treatment, the change to a 3-year maximum license period will be effective after completion of the current license period.
