Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7801, sub-§20, ¶¶T and U, as enacted by PL
4 2001, c. 638, §3, are amended to read:

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T. Operates a motorboat having more than 10 horsepower on
Middle Branch Pond in the Town of Waterboro in York County;

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U. Operates a motorboat having more than 10 horsepower on
Adams Pond, Foster Pond or Otter Pond in the Town of
12 Bridgton in Cumberland County; or

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Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7801, sub-§20, ¶V is enacted to read:

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V. Operates a motorboat having more than 10 horsepower on
18 Paradise Pond in the Town of Damariscotta in Lincoln County.

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SUMMARY

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This bill prohibits the operation of a motorboat equipped
with a motor greater than 10 horsepower on Paradise Pond in the
24 Town of Damariscotta in Lincoln County.

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
