
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1101, L.D. 1508, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Chapter 7: Rules Advancing the Performance of Sound Student Safety Practices in Maine's Public Schools and Colleges, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Standards"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the first 2 lines (page 2, lines 17 and 18 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs" and inserting in its place the following: 'Legislature'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in the 9th and 10th lines (page 2, lines 25 and 26 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs" and inserting in its place the following: 'Legislature'
