32	SUMMARY
34	This amendment replaces the bill. The bill sought to conform the statute to developments in case law since the initial
36	enactment of this statute. It has become clear, however, that the law in this area is insufficiently precise to be codified in
38	statute. The rules provided for in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 200-G, subsection 1 are a sufficient means to
10	provide guidance to law enforcement officers in this area and are much easier to amend if case law developments warrant such a change.

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
