COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1116, L.D. 1525, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the Freedom of Access Laws as They Pertain to the Penobscot Nation"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Clarify the Freedom of Access Laws as They Pertain to the Penobscot Nation and the Passamaquoddy Tribe'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~S411.~~" in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Nation" the following: 'or the Passamaquoddy Tribe'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the bill to provide that the freedom of access laws concerning public records do not apply to the Passamaquoddy Tribe.
