SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1139, L.D. 1556, Bill, "An Act To Reapportion the Districts for Representatives to the United States Congress"

Amend the bill in section 2 in the 4th and 5th lines from the end (page 1, lines 12 and 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A," and inserting in its place the following: 'Notwithstanding the 120-day time requirement contained in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A, section 1206, subsection 2, and notwithstanding Title 21-A, section 1207, subsection 3,'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment specifies that it is only the nonseverability provision and the internally inconsistent deadline in the statutes governing reapportionment that are being "notwithstood"; all of the other requirements remain applicable.
