COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 524, L.D. 1561, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the InforME Public Information Access Act"

Amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 10 in the last line (page 1, line 41 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "electronically." the following: 'State funds must be either directly deposited into an account of the Treasurer of State or transferred in a timely manner to a state deposit account as mutually agreed upon by the Treasurer of State and InforME.'

Further amend the bill in section 8 in paragraph M in the first line (page 3, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "funds" the following: 'pursuant to section 533, subsection 10'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in paragraph K in the last line (page 3, line 30 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "agencies" the following: 'pursuant to section 533, subsection 10'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that InforME must follow certain requirements regarding the depositing of state funds.
