HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1148, L.D. 1566, Bill, "An Act To Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of \$70,000,000 for Municipal Facilities and for Investments in Research, Development, Farming and Affordable Housing in Order To Sustain and Improve Maine's Economy"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part B the following:

PART C

Sec. C-1. Reimbursement for costs of statewide election.

Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the State shall reimburse each city, town and plantation for any costs incurred by that city, town or plantation in holding the statewide election in June as required by Part A of this Act.

Sec. C-2. Appropriations and allocations. The following

appropriations and allocations are made.

Bureau of Administrative Services and Corporations

Initiative: Appropriates funds for reimbursing municipalities for the estimated costs of holding a special election in June of 2003.



**Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Reimbursing municipalities for the costs of a special election to be held in June of 2003 will require an additional General Fund appropriation of \$350,000 in fiscal year 2003-04 to the Department of the Secretary of State.
