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SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. The amendment retains the provision in the original bill that amends the date for full implementation of the school administrative unit's gifted and talented program, but changes the implementation date for gifted and talented programs from the 2003-2004 school year to the 2004-2005 school year. The amendment also provides that, beginning with the 2004-2005 school year, a school administrative unit may request a one-year waiver from the Commissioner of Education on the requirement for fully implementing its plan for phasing in its gifted and talented program.
