COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "" to H.P. 1160, L.D. 1587

Class E crime except that violation of this section is a Class D crime when the person has one or more prior convictions for violation of this section. Title 17-A, section 9-A governs the use of prior convictions when determining a sentence.

- 6 Each stamp affixed and each offer to sell cigarettes in violation of subsection 7 constitutes a separate violation.'
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SUMMARY

12 This amendment requires the Attorney General to notify the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of 14 Revenue Services of certified tobacco products manufacturers. The amendment also makes technical corrections to violations and 16 penalty subsections to be consistent with the MCJUSTIS drafting directives pursuant to Resolve 1997, chapter 105, as amended. 18 The purpose is to provide that each separate offense has a unique statutory cite to enable computerized databases and accurate 20 tracking of offenses and offenders.
