32	8-A. Water quality. A person may not bathe or wash articles of personal apparel in or upon the waters of Hatcase Pond. A person may not engage in or attempt to engage in boating or		
34	fishing in or upon the waters of Hatcase Pond within 2,000 feet of the intake of the City of Brewer. A person may not engage in		
36	or attempt to engage in swimming in or upon the waters of Hatcase Pond within 3,000 feet of the intake of the City of Brewer. A		
38	person who violates this subsection commits a civil violation for which a fine or not more than \$500 must be adjudged for each		
40	offense. The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall enforce this subsection.'
