Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §3104 is enacted to read:
§3104. Monthly meter reading
A transmission and distribution utility as defined in
section 102 shall read and record on a monthly basis all active
and reasonably accessible meters furnished to that utility's
customers for the purpose of measuring the electricity provided
by that utility to its customers.
SUMMARY
This bill requires a transmission and distribution utility
providing electricity to its customers to read and record on a
monthly basis the reasonably accessible meters furnished to that
utility's customers.
