Dirigo Health offer an optional plan for public school teachers. Under the optional plan, a teacher could elect coverage under Dirigo Health and that teacher's contribution to the Dirigo Health Fund would be 4% of the annual salary earned from teaching and the State's contribution would be 40% of the cost of health insurance coverage.

### **Fiscal Note**

Undetermined current biennium cost increase - General Fund

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The additional cost to the state to contribute 40% of the cost of health insurance for public school teachers cannot be determined at this time and will depend on the number of teachers who elect to participate in the plan. The state currently pays a percentage of health insurance for retired teachers but not for active teachers. The savings to local school units can not be determined at this time but would be significant.
