SENATE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1209, L.D. 1629, "RESOLUTION, Proposing a Competing Measure under the Constitution of Maine To Create Municipal Service Districts To Reduce the Cost of Local Government, To Provide Property Tax Relief and To Increase Economic Competitiveness"

Amend the amendment by striking out the substitute title and replacing it with the following:

'RESOLUTION, Proposing a Competing Measure under the Constitution of Maine To Reduce the Cost of Local Government through Increased State Education Funding and Provide Property Tax Relief'

Further amend the amendment in Part A in section 2 in that part designated "§15671-A." by striking out all of subsection 3.

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of Part B.

Further amend the amendment on page 8 in the question in the first to 4th lines (page 8, lines 21 to 24 in amendment) by striking out the following: ", without raising Maine sales and personal income taxes, by having the State pay 55% of the cost of public education and capping municipal spending to achieve significant savings at the local level" and inserting in its place the following: 'and avoid the need for a major increase in state taxes by phasing in a 55% state contribution to the cost of public education'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$40,000 in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$80,000 in fiscal year 2006-07 due to the elimination of the provisions concerning a cap on municipal appropriations and its impact on the Department of Audit.
