24	'An Act To Prohibit the Sale of Nicotine Water to Minors'

28	Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:
30	'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1556-B is enacted to read:
32	Sec. 1. 22 Minor \$1350-D IS enacted to read.
34	<u>§1556-B. Nicotine water</u>
74	1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the
36	context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.

40	A. "Nicotine water" means water that is sold in this State, that is intended for human consumption and that contains as an added ingredient nicotine or an alkaloid having similar
42	physiological activity.
44	2. Prohibition. A person may not sell, furnish, give away or offer to sell, furnish or give away nicotine water to any
46	person under 18 years of age. Nicotine water may not be sold at retail to any person under 27 years of age unless the seller
48	first verifies that person's age by means of reliable photographic identification containing the person's date of birth.

2	3. Sales through vending machines. Nicotine water may not be sold through vending machines.
4	4. Possession and use of nicotine water. Except as
6	provided in subsection 5, a person under 18 years of age may not:
8	A. Purchase, possess or use nicotine water;
10	<u>B. Violate paragraph A after having previously violated this subsection; or</u>
12	C. Violate paragraph A after having previously violated
14	this subsection 2 or more times.
16	5. Exception to possession by minor. Notwithstanding subsection 4, a person under 18 years of age may transport or
18	permit to be transported in a motor vehicle nicotine water in the original sealed package in which it was placed by the
20	manufacturer if the transportation is in the scope of that person's employment.
22	6. Fines. A person who violates this section is subject to
24	the following fines.
26	A. A person who violates subsection 2 or 3 commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$50 and not more
28	than \$1,500, plus court costs, must be adjudged for any one offense. Except pursuant to Title 15, section 3314, the
30	fine may not be suspended.
32	<u>B. An employer of a person who violates subsection 2 or 3 commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than</u>
34	<u>\$50 and not more than \$1,500, plus court costs, must be adjudged. The fine may not be suspended.</u>

38	C. A person who violates subsection 4 commits a civil violation for which the following fines may be adjudged.
40	(1) For a first offense, a fine of not less than \$100 and not more than \$300 may be imposed. The court, as
42	an alternative to or in addition to the fine permitted by this subparagraph, may assign the violator to
44	perform specified work for the benefit of the State, the municipality or other public entity or a charitable
46	institution.
48	(2) For a 2nd offense, a fine of not less than \$200 and not more than \$500 may be imposed. The court, as

	the purchaser.

	8. Manner of display and offer for sale. Nicotine water
22	may be displayed or offered for sale only in a manner that does
	not allow direct access to the nicotine water.'

20	This amendment is the minority report of the committee. The
20	amendment replaces the bill. It imposes on the sale of nicotine
30	water restrictions that are similar to the restrictions on the
22	sale of cigarettes and tobacco products to minors and
32	restrictions on the location of the product in stores.
