32	Each sale or possession in violation of this section constitutes a separate violation for purposes of calculating the fine.
34	SUMMARY
36	This bill prohibits the sale or possession of water laced
38	with nicotine in this State and establishes a fine of \$500 for a first offense, \$1,000 for a 2nd offense and \$5,000 for a 3rd of subsequent offense.
