SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1213, L.D. 1636, Bill, "An Act To Make Additional Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and To Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2004 and June 30, 2005"

Amend the bill by inserting after Part C the following:

PART D

Sec. D-1. PL 2003, c. 333, §22 is repealed.

Sec. D-2. Effective date. That section of this Part that repeals Public Law 2003, chapter 333, section 22 takes effect September 13, 2003.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

Public Law 2003, chapter 333 repealed the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 7464, subsection 7, which prohibits the illegal possession of a gift moose, and Title 12, section 7464, subsection 8, which prohibits the buying and selling of moose. Although the repeal of Title 12, section 7467, subsection 7 was intentional, Title 12, section 7467, subsection 8 was repealed in error. This amendment repeals the section of chapter

333 that repeals subsection 8, thus leaving subsection 8 in force. Further, it makes the change effective September 13, 2003, which is the date chapter 333 takes effect.
