22	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

26	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

30	Whereas, municipalities may hold referenda and elections at any time during the year and, notably, the Town of Harpswell will hold a major referendum on March 9, 2004; and

34	Whereas, Maine is a national leader in encouraging voter participation, which can be enhanced by making access to the polls easier; and
36	Whereas, the cost of managing voting in a polling place
38	affording only difficult access and requiring crowd control may be greater than the cost of the use of multiple polling places;

42	Whereas, cold winter weather imposes a hardship on voters required to wait outdoors to vote for lengthy periods because of
44	limited access to a voting place; and

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 10 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'
