20 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 604, L.D. 1653, Bill, "An
Act To Authorize the Town of Verona To Change Its Name"

22 Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the
enacting clause the following:

26 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

30 'Whereas, the Town of Verona requires approval from the
Legislature in order to hold an election on March 27, 2004 to
change the name of the town to "Town of Verona Island"; and

34 'Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
36 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,'

40 Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

42 Further amend the bill by inserting after section 6 and
before the summary the following:

44
46 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act takes effect when approved, except as
otherwise indicated.'

8 This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency
clause to the bill. This amendment also removes that section of
10 the bill that amends a senatorial district as it existed prior to
the redistricting effected by the Supreme Judicial Court.
