_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11209, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 414, Pt. A,
4	§2 and affected by Pt. D, §7, is amended to read:
6	§11209. Discharge of firearm near dwelling
8	1. Prohibition. A person may not:
10	A. Unless a relevant municipal ordinance provides otherwise and except as provided in sections 12401 and 12402,
12	discharge a firearm within 100 yards of a residential dwelling without the permission of the owner or, in the
14	owner's absence, of an adult occupant of that dwelling; or
16	B. Possess a wild animal or wild bird taken in violation of this subsection, except as otherwise provided in this Part.
18	This subsection may not be supplied to such this course from
20	This subsection may not be construed to prohibit a person from killing or taking a wild animal in accordance with sections 12401 and 12402.

24	As used in this subsection, "residential dwelling" includes livestock barns.
26	A person who violates this subsection commits a Class E crime.

	This bill clarifies that residential dwellings include
