## An Act To Require Owners and Operators of Snowmobiles and Allterrain Vehicles To Carry Liability Insurance

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13001-A is enacted to read:
4 6	§13001-A. Liability insurance prerequisite to registration of snowmobile or ATV
8	<b>1. Prerequisite to registration.</b> A person may not register a snowmobile or ATV in this State after June 30, 2005 unless the
10 12	person satisfies the commissioner or an agent designated by the commissioner that the snowmobile or ATV is covered by a liability insurance policy in accordance with this section.
14	2. Standards for liability coverage. Liability insurance
16	coverage under this section must be obtained at a minimum of:
18	A. For damage to property, \$25,000;
20	B. For injury to or death of any one person, \$50,000;
22	<u>C. For one accident resulting in injury to or death of more</u> than one person, \$100,000; and
24	D. For medical payments pursuant to subsection 3, \$1,000.
26	<b>3. Medical payments.</b> A liability insurance policy issued for a snowmobile or ATV registered in this State must provide
28	coverage in an amount equal to or greater than \$1,000 per person for medical costs incurred as a result of injuries sustained in
30	an accident involving the insured snowmobile or ATV. The coverage required by this section applies only to medical costs incurred
32	during one year following the date the injuries are sustained.
34	<b><u>4. Maintenance of liability insurance required.</u></b> After June 30, 2005, the owner of a snowmobile or ATV required to be
36	registered in this State shall maintain at all times the required amount of insurance under subsection 2 during the term of the
38	registration of the snowmobile or ATV. A person who violates this subsection commits a civil violation for which a fine of not
40 42	<u>less than \$100 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.</u> 5. Evidence of registration. An operator of a snowmobile
	or ATV must carry evidence of insurance at all times that the
