	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
	as emergencies; and
4	Whereas, the purpose of this legislation is to disallow the
6	shipment of large brood lobsters through Maine; and
8	Whereas, this legislation will help protect Maine's lobster industry and ensure the long-term viability of this valuable
10	resource; and
12	Whereas, legislative action is immediately necessary in order to protect the lobster industry while fishermen are
14	enjoying record lobster catches and while the State is experiencing a relatively healthy fishery; and
16	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
18	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
