HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1244, L.D. 1668, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Governing Growth Management"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 3-A in paragraph A in subparagraph (2) in the 4th line (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "has" and inserting in its place the following: 'and has'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 3-A in paragraph A in subparagraph (2) in the 6th and 7th lines (page 2, lines 6 and 7 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and is implementing a capital investment plan according to schedule;" and inserting in its place the following: '; and'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 3-A in paragraph A in subparagraph (3) in the last line (page 2, line 12 in amendment) by striking out the following: "; and" and inserting in its place the following: '.'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in subsection 3-A in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraph (4) (page 2, lines 14 and 15 in amendment)


